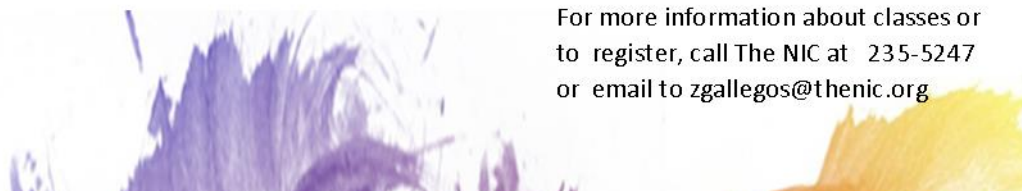
NEW: Art Play
