**Where?** We will travel around Casper area field trip sites to learn about local plants, birds, animals, rocks, and fossils. Some of the sites we will visit are Edness Kimball Wilkins State Park, the Alcova/Pathfinder area, Casper Mountain, Bates Creek, and Speas Fish Hatchery.

**When?** June 17-21, 8:45 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily.
